Objections to a Competitor on the ground that he/she is not qualified to enter in a certain class will be considered if lodged in writing with the Secretary, together with a fee of £10.00, at or before 3 00 o'clock on Saturday. This fee will be returned if a valid objection is sustained; otherwise it will be forfeited to Funds of Show.
- 9 Should any matter arise not provided for in the purview of these Rules and Regulations, such matter shall be referred to the Committee, whose decision shall be final and binding, no appeal to law in any case being permitted.
